COURSE DESCRIPTION:

The course is structured with demos and projects that will develop your technique using this exciting medium.

Suitable for students that have experience using watercolour but want to refresh their knowledge and improve techniques.

The course looks at colour and the composition of painting. Some of the techniques that you will look at include:

- Wet on wet
- Texture techniques e.g. using Wax/Salt.
- Using Masking fluid and Resist
- Composition and design of paintings
- Use of colour
- Looking at local and famous artist.

Taught by professional artist and qualified tutor Emma Rhydderch Price.

We arrange optional visits to galleries and social evenings, as well as arranging exhibitions where we invite our learners to display their artwork.

PRE-REQUISITES:

Some knowledge of working with watercolour.

OUTCOMES:

During the course you will produce a number of unique pieces of artwork from the projects set by the tutor, including a sketchbook with the techniques learnt.

ANY MATERIALS/EQUIPMENT REQUIRED BY STUDENTS:

Watercolours, Watercolour brushes, Watercolour Paper, Sketchbook, Pencils, Masking fluid, a board and masking tape.
