Directions and Parking

Llanvihangel Crucorney is five miles north of Abergavenny on the A465. Driving from Abergavenny you will see a large sign on the left for Llanvihangel Crucorney and Llanthony Priory etc - Do Not Take This Turn. About 500 yards further along on the right is a turn to Llanvihangel Court. There are two sign posts, one on either side of the road. If you are driving south from the Hereford end, once you have gone through Pandy you will see the turning to Llanvihangel Court on your left.
